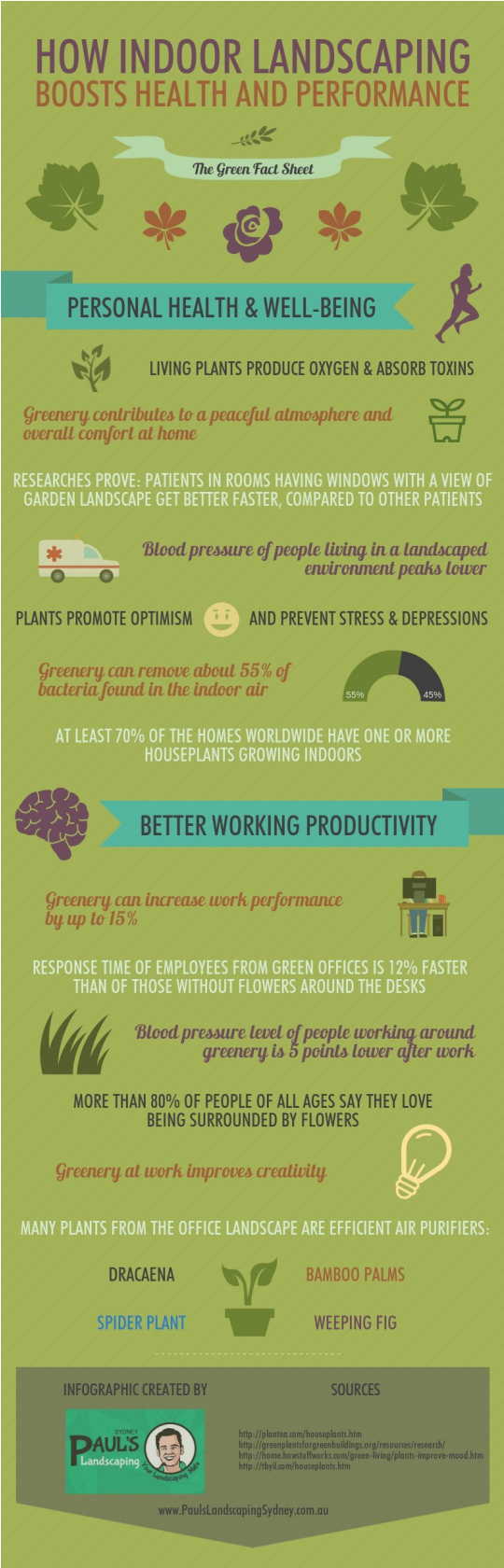

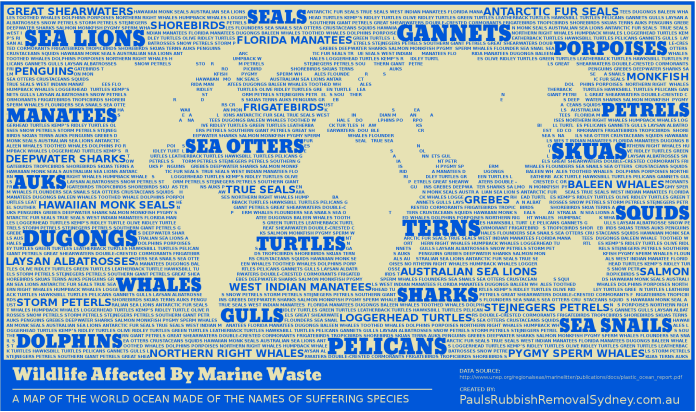

# Pros and Cons of Natural Window Cleaning Solutions

## Pros and Cons of Using Natural Cleaners

### Pros:

- ✓ Safety - Standard cleaning products include toxic ingredients. Home-made ones - don't.
- ✓ Easy-to-make - Most home-made cleaners take just few minutes to make
- ✓ Save money - making a window cleaning solution by yourself, would always be cheaper than buying a commercial product.

### Cons:

- ✓ Effectiveness - Natural cleaners are less effective in many cases, especially if you have to clean tough stains.
- ✓ Use on different surfaces- Depending on the place you clean, different products might have different effect. For example, vinegar is great for windows, but could destroy marble.
- ✓ Possible irritations. Also mixing different ingredients could create harmful gas. Be sure you know what you are mixing.

## Pro Window Cleaning Tip

- ✓ 2 cups of water
- ✓ 1/4 cup white vinegar
- ✓ 1 tbsp. cornstarch
- ✓ Spray bottle

Mix the ingredients in the spray bottle. Shake well. Spray the windows. Wipe off with a soft cloth or an old newspaper. Enjoy spotless windows.
